

OTTAWA COUNTY COMMON PLEAS COURT
PROBATION/PRE-TRIAL/PRE-SENTENCE DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING POLICY

IN LIEU OF INCARCERATION YOU HAVE BEEN GRANTED BOND, WHILE YOUR CASE IS PENDING. AS A CONDITION OF THAT BOND YOU HAVE BEEN ORDERED TO SUBMIT TO RANDOM DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING, FAILURE TO DO SO IS A VIOLATION OF BOND CONDITIONS, AND WILL RESULT IN IMMEDIATE REVOCATION OF YOUR BOND AND IMMEDIATE INCARCERATION.

AS A CONDITION OF PROBATION YOU ARE REQUIRED TO SUBMIT TO RANDOM DRUG AND/OR ALCOHOL TESTING. FAILURE TO DO SO IS A VIOLATION OF PROBATION CONDITIONS AND WILL RESULT IN A PROBATION VIOLATION BEING FILED.

1. You shall call 419-734-6893 every day including weekends and holidays between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 10:00 a.m.
2. Your color(s) is/are _____ . The recording will advise you what colors are testing for that day.
3. On days your color or colors are to be tested, you must report to the Adult Probation Department Office on that same day before 12:00 (noon) or between 1:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m. On weekends and holidays you will be instructed by the recording where and when to report for testing.
4. You must provide to the Adult Probation Department documentation verifying all prescriptions you are taking within One (1) business day of being placed on bond.
5. You must advise all medical care providers that you are subject to regular drug testing and that you are expected to avoid use of controlled substances whenever possible.
6. If after you have explained this to the medical provider, and he/she believe that it is medically necessary and in your best interest to prescribe a controlled substance, a statement to that effect must be provided to the probation department within one business day of being prescribed the medication.
7. If you test positive at commencement of the bond for any substance, the sample will be referred to TASC to obtain a specific quantitative level. Thereafter, samples will be run for quantitative levels to confirm lower concentrations, until you test negative.
8. A Positive drug screen shall be determined by the cut-offs outlined in the chart on the back of this page. A B.A.C. result greater than .02 shall be considered a bond violation.
9. You must consume no supplement or anything designed to "clean", "cleanse", or "flush" the system. Such a product can be detected and is an **ALTERED SAMPLE**. You shall not consume large quantities of water so as to produce a diluted sample.
10. ANYONE PROVIDING AN ALTERED SAMPLE, INSERTING ANYTHING INTO THE SAMPLE, OR ATTEMPTING TO PROVIDE A SAMPLE NOT THEIR OWN WILL BE CHARGED WITH TAMPERING WITH EVIDENCE, A FELONY OF THE THIRD DEGREE PUNISHABLE WITH UP TO FIVE YEARS IN PRISON AND A FINE OF UP TO \$10,000.00.

BY SIGNING BELOW, DEFENDANT STATES THAT HE/SHE UNDERSTANDS THE RULES OF DRUG AND ALCOHOL TESTING AND THAT ANY AND ALL QUESTIONS HAVE BEEN ANSWERED.

The One Step Drug Screen Test Card is a lateral flow chromatographic immunoassay for the qualitative detection of multiple drugs and drug metabolites in urine at the following cut-off concentrations:
